FLANNEL BABY BURP CLOTHS

Supplies: 1 yd 45-inch flannel fabric and 1 yard of coordinating flannel fabric, sewing machine, thread, pins, measuring tape.

Directions:

- 1. Wash fabric before sewing.
- 2. Make a template out of tissue or interfacing. Write seam allowance and measurements on the pattern. Try to get 6 cloths from a one-yard piece of 45" fabric. Template measurements are: 11" wide and somewhere between 17-18.5" long. Round corners of template using a cup or bowl.
- 3. Adjust template as needed. Cut 6 cloths from each 1 yard piece of fabric.
- 4. Pin 2 coordinating fabrics right sides together and sew around the outside with a 3/8" seam allowance. Leave a 4" opening to turn the cloth.
- 5. Clip the corners and turn right sides out. Turn the edges of the 4" opening under and pin.
- 6. Sew around the cloths ¼" from the outside to finish.
- 7. Package 4 to 6 for gifts.
