

**Lily Baby Beagle Dog Ami'Pal
Amigurumi Stuffed Puppy Pattern
by Mary Walker**

Size: 10" or 12"



Materials

I Love This Cotton or other medium weight yarn
Colors White (W), Brown (B) and Black (BL)
Hook size F (3.75 mm)
Toy stuffing material
Your choice of eyes and nose
Tapestry or large sewing needle

Notes

Finished Size approximately 7" / 17 cm

Since the gauge does not need to be matched exactly the overall size can be changed by adjusting yarn weight and hook size, feel free to experiment.

In this pattern we're working in the round all stitches are to be repeated for the entire round unless otherwise instructed.

Abbreviations

mr=magic ring
sc=single crochet
inc=increase
dec=decrease
FO=finish off

Instructions

Head

brown

R1 6 sc on mr (6)

join white keep brown attached

R2 W 1 inc, B inc (W2, B10)

R3 W 1 sc, inc then B sc, inc (W3, B15)

R4 W 2 sc, inc then B sc, inc (W4, B20)

R5 W 3 sc, inc then B 3 sc, inc (W5, B25)

R6 W 4 sc, inc then B 4 sc, inc (W6, B30)

if using safety/post eyes insert now at approximately R5

R7-8 sc even (W6, B30)

tie off white and continue with brown only

R9-11 sc even (36)

R12 4 sc, dec (30)

R13 3 sc, dec (24)

R14 2 sc, dec (18)

R15 1 sc, dec (12)

insert stuffing

R16 dec all (6)

FO close



Body

black

R1 6 sc on mr (6)

join white keep black attached

R2 W 1 inc, BL inc (W2, BL10)

R3 W 1 sc, inc then BL sc, inc (W3, BL15)

R4 W 2 sc, inc then BL sc, inc (W4, BL20)

R5 W 3 sc, inc then BL 3 sc, inc (W5, BL25)

join brown keep white attached tie off black

R6 W 4 sc, inc then B 4 sc, inc (W6, B30)

R7 W 5 sc, inc then B 4 sc, inc (W7, B35)

R8-12 sc even (W7, B35)

tie off brown and continue with white only

R13 5 sc, dec (36)

R14 4 sc, dec (30)

R15 3 sc, dec (24)

R16 2 sc, dec (18)

R17 1 sc, dec (12)

insert stuffing

R18 dec all (6)

FO close

Front Legs (make 2)

white

R1 6 sc on mr (6)

R2 inc all (12)

R3 sc, inc (18)

R4 2 dec, 14 sc even (16)

R5 2 dec, 12 sc even (14)

R6 2 dec, 10 sc even (12)

R7 sc even (12)

join brown tie off white

R8-11 sc even (12)

FO open with 12" extra yarn for sewing

Back Legs (make 2)

white

R1 6 sc on mr (6)

R2 inc all (12)

R3 1 sc, inc (18)

R4 2 sc, inc (24)

R5 sc even (24)

R6 3 dec, 18 sc even (21)

R7 3 dec, 15 sc even (18)

R8 sc even (18)

R9 1 sc, dec (12)

join brown and tie off white

R10-14 sc even (12)

FO open with 12" extra yarn for sewing

Muzzle

white

R1 6 sc on mr (6)

R2 inc all (12)

R3 1 sc, inc (18)

R4-7 even (18)

FO open with 9" extra yarn for sewing

Ears (make 2)

brown

R1 5 sc on mr (5)

R2 inc all (10)

R3 1 sc, inc (15)

R4 2 sc, inc (20)

R5-9 sc even (20)

R10 2 sc, dec (15)

R11 1 sc, dec (10)

FO open with 9" extra yarn for sewing, flatten in half

Tail

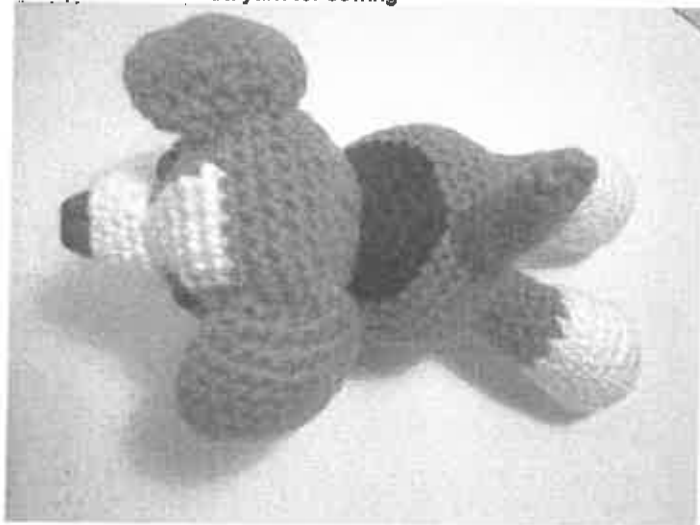
brown

R1 sc 4 in mr (4)

R2 inc all (8)

R3-9 sc even (8)

FO open with 9" extra yarn for sewing



Assembly

Stuff head, body, legs, muzzle and tail

Do not stuff ears

slightly firm but not showing stuffing through stitches

Approximate round locations for sewing parts together:

Ears on top of head R9-12

Muzzle on front of face below eyes R2

Legs on side of body R10-14 and R13-16

Tail on rear of body R9-11

Head on top of body R1-6 above front legs

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
