PURPOSE:

To provide an ongoing professional practice evaluation to practitioners in the Surgical/Trauma Services

POLICY STATEMENT:

To set forth the policy for conducting ongoing professional practice evaluation (OPPE) for practitioner’s ability to provide safe, high quality patient care as identified through the peer review/ongoing professional practice review process.

ENTITIES AFFECTED BY THIS POLICY (SCOPE):

WPP Surgery

WHO SHOULD READ THIS POLICY:

Trauma Attending, Trauma Advanced Practice Provider

PROCEDURES:

- I. Practice evaluation is provided quarterly and includes information related to care of the injured patient, all of which are benchmarked against the trauma service, overall trauma registry, and NTDB.
 - trauma admissions
 - activations
 - severity of injury
 - mortality rates
 - Response times
 - ICU and Hospital length of stay.
 - i. Benchmarked against the trauma service and registry overall.

- II. Monthly review of PI filters that may be identified as indicative of practice or performance include:
 - ICU admit without activation
 - Response times
 - Unplanned return to ICU
 - Unplanned return to OR
 - Complications
 - Other

- III. Feedback is provided on an ongoing basis for identified issues following review in Trauma Outcomes Committee in the form of a PIPS letter, formal review letter, general email, or record of a face-to-face meeting.
